HOPE IN THE VALLEY

"Often when families come to us, we want to instill in them the hope that says God has a plan for their lives," explains In-Home Family Support Program Director, Sergio Trejo. "We all go through different seasons and challenges. We can ask God what He wants to teach us through the experience or we can just say 'why me'".

Interventionist Misty Evans shares her perspective on the hope offered to families in the In-Home Family Support Program:

I am here to be the hands and feet of Jesus. I tell new families in our program, I am here to love you, to encourage you and to support you, no matter what that looks like. I am here to be your advocate. His light can shine through me to these families. Soon they do feel hope. That may look different than it did before CPS was involved or before CPS removed their children or before we were involved. They begin to see a ray of hope.

Evans had the opportunity recently to work with a single mom with five children. While she had custody of four children she was still working on getting custody of one. This mother was disconnected from the church but because her child was placed with a Christian foster family who regularly attended church, the mother began to attend. That mother is now a believer and actively involved with her children in the church. She has worked hard on achieving goals in the program and the requirements to have full custody of all her children.



This mother provides a perfect example of a client who acknowledges the valley she is in while also acknowledging that there is hope and God is able to work in their situation.

The families referred to this program come from all socio economic backgrounds. Every family situation is different. They are often living with generational misinformation or deep hurts that are affecting the health of their family. Interventionists serve families in all 82 counties who have been referred to the BCV through Child Protection Services or private families themselves.

As is true for all BCV programs, The In-Home Family Support Program team utilizes Trust Based Relational Intervention (TBRI) principles in their work with families. "The first key," explains Trejo, "is trust. If they can't trust God, our goal is to help them see God wants us to trust Him." He often reminds families about the truth of Proverbs 3:5-6 that says, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your

own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him and he will make straight your paths.”

Evans also finds the TBRI principles helpful when teaching families about appropriate discipline and that there is a reason for every behavior. She explains that most of the adults are dealing with their own trauma so it is necessary for Interventionists to help them deal with their trauma

before they can understand how to effectively parent their children.

Interventionists each work with families who have unique needs and develop a plan of care that is specific to them. Each family is introduced to hope in the midst of their deep valley.

IF I HAD NOT COME TO THE BCV, I WOULD HAVE NEVER KNOWN CHRIST



“I didn't enjoy everything about the BCV but the one thing that I will always be grateful for is that if I had not come to the BCV I would have never known Christ.” These are the piercing words of a recent alumnus. Former Houseparent, now Campus Director Tim Lampley reflects, “First and foremost, my goal is to see these kids encounter the gospel, believe in the Lord Jesus and be saved. We leave the outcomes to God but the responsibility is ours to love these kids consistently and share with them as God gives us those opportunities to share naturally and enthusiastically.

Fulfilling that responsibility is exactly what Residential Child Caring Program staff do every day. Lampley and Reedy Acres Campus Case Manager Rachel Rainey agree that as they work to accomplish the BCV mission to “provide at-risk children and families with hope and a strong foundation for their future,” an

individualized plan of care is developed for each child and that process is best described as a compilation of building blocks. Lampley explains:

Everybody involved in the ministry contributes to the building blocks of the success of children and families. Whether sports or the arts or community activities, the BCV has the privilege of offering a variety of experiences that help contribute to the overall success of the child or young adult. Those building blocks come from staff and community and church partners. Each block complements others. The end goal is to see children come to know Christ, to excel educationally. We also want to see them develop character that will suit them to be successful in life and in their relationships and with jobs, but the day in and day out is such a normal process that flows out of everyone's love of



Christ, love for the children, their trust in the scripture, and their hope that these kids will really succeed. Their success is built on the foundation of love, God’s love, the love of others. The Plan of Care really reflects what we want to see achieved for the child.

The BCV currently operates the Residential Child Caring Program on five campuses around the state of Mississippi. Children ages 1-20 live in houses on campuses in Coldwater, Water Valley, Florence, Brookhaven and Wiggins. These campuses are staffed with Houseparent Missionaries who provide daily parental care, Case Managers, a Ministry Assistant and a Campus Director. Children on these campuses attend local public schools and are

involved in a local host church. Those who graduate high school can transition to the BCV Independent Living Program where they pursue college, technical training or begin a career path.

All of this is possible because of BCV partners who pray for the ministry and provide 100% of the support. This includes daily needs and big needs like the recent renovation of cottages that Lampley hopes are an “oasis” for children who are coming from often very chaotic environments. While these tangible gifts are critical to the Residential Child Caring Program, Lampley says, “If we are going to see true success it will be because God has moved, so prayer must be the first work.”



PERSONAL REFLECTION

The calendar read February 1961, The BCV Board meeting was scheduled four months into the new administration of Mr. Paul N. Nunnery. He boldly reported the need for the following actions:

- Amend the corporate charter changing the name of the agency from the **Baptist Orphanage to The Baptist Children's Village** to more accurately reflect the identity of the ministry and its clients.
- Close the school operated on the large campus and enroll children in the public school allowing for a more natural and comprehensive community and education experience.
- Replace a bus in need of repair and bearing the name "Baptist Orphanage" with a safer bus that looked more like the buses other community children were riding to school.
- The institution of a more formal recreational program that allowed for intentional play and structured sports teams for boys and girls to compete in the community.

As our calendar now turns to February 2025 the BCV ministry continues its efforts to provide quality care and hope for children and families in Mississippi. Every day staff work to build a strong foundation for each of our clients offering hope for their future. Campus staff are all trained in Trust Based Relational Intervention Therapy (TBRI). Just as Paul Nunnery sought to avoid re-traumatizing children by forcing them to ride a bus with humiliating words painted on it, or subjecting them to isolation in an on-campus school, our staff understand that children and families come to us having experienced significant trauma. Often well meaning untrained people innocently re-traumatize them making healing

a challenge. BCV professional staff are intentionally trained to encourage healing in the face of chaos and pain.

It was 65 years ago when then Superintendent Paul Nunnery swiftly implemented trail-blazing changes to meet the needs of hurting children and families. Today, our current administration continues to lead the BCV team to consider the current need and offer hope and a strong foundation to clients, and to boldly implement programs and practices to meet those needs.

Nunnery would later explain that, "The survival and usefulness of any service agency is dependent, in large measure, upon its capacity and willingness to change." God has provided strong leadership through directors and board members who have maintained the ministry and continued its usefulness for almost 128 years. Because that leadership has had the courage and willingness to change when necessary, thousands of children and families have experienced God's healing in their lives.
